NATIONAL ARCHERY DAY MEMBER TARGET THEME COMPETITION

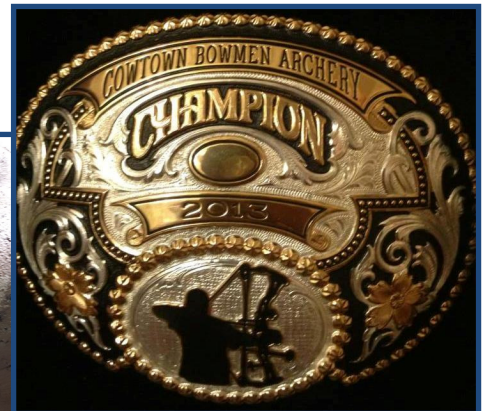

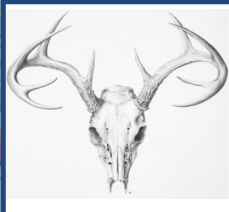


Cowtown Club Championship

BYLAWS CHANGES PROPOSED

At our Annual meeting this month, August 19th @ 7pm at Spring Creek BBQ in Lake Worth, the board will be presenting a revised Bylaws for vote to approve. The last set of bylaws for Cowtown Archery Club we done in 2000, and with the changes that the club has undergone in the last 13 years, the board and officers felt we needed to update some of the language in the bylaws to bring it up to date. These changes will add language to how the board and officers contact members, correcting our dues, changing our affiliations [adding ASA and TFAA and removing IBO and USA], and officially changing our monthly meeting to third Monday, as it has been for the last year or so. We are also going to be deleting a few board positions, Hunt Chairman and Concessions Chairman, for the reason that these positions have been largely unused in the past few years and the board feels that they are for the most part obsolete.

If you have any questions or concerns, or would like to review the old bylaws and the proposed version to see what is being changed and removed, please feel free to either come to the August Meeting or call me personally, and I will make every effort to meet with you to discuss.

Question: What does a member need to do to become a Club Officer or Board Director?

Answer: Our current Club By-Laws say you must be a current member in good standing for one year to run for office, or 60 days or referred by a member for a board position. Term is for one year, beginning immediately after the Club Elections in August, thru the next Annual Meeting the following year. The Board is responsible for all operations of the club and does so at the direction of the membership at large. The Board meets every third Monday of the month at Spring Creek BBQ in Lake Worth. These meetings are to conduct club business, hear proposals for new or ongoing projects, and discuss avenues for promotion of the club and archery. All members are welcome to come to the meetings and voice their comments or concerns and provide input. We run this club with one goal in mind, and that is making Cowtown Bowmen the best club in the region for all of our members to enjoy.
