### Shoot Fees \$10 per Shooter

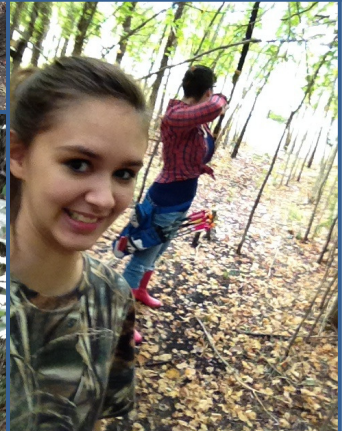

There will also be a prize for best carved pumpkin, so bring what you got.



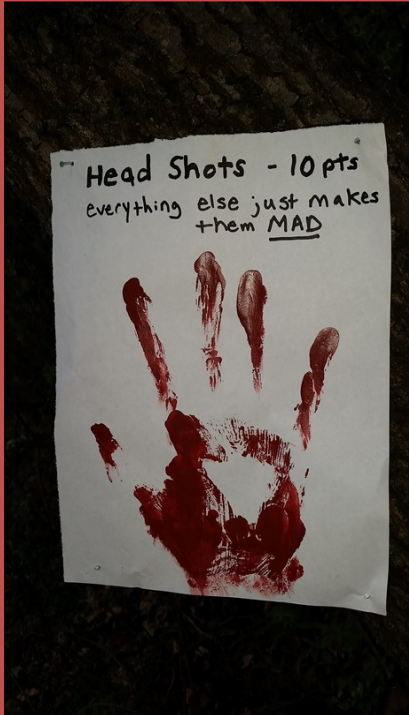
